

Lesson on European Green deal

13+

Learning objectives

- Learn the fundamentals of the EU Green Deal.
- Consider how everyone of us can contribute to the EU's zero-carbon goals.
- Students will work in groups to strengthen their presentation, teamwork, and communication skills.

Structure/activities

- **Show the video** that has been provided as a learning resource. The video features **subtitles in various languages**, it will help the process to understand the concept.
- After the video, once again **go through the major aspects of Green Deal** - that it is a plan which intends to place the EU on the route to a green transition, with the **ultimate objective of reaching climate neutrality by 2050**. **The roadmap** can be used by teachers to learn more about the Green Deal and provide more diverse information.
- After that, **split class into groups** of 3 to 4 persons (depends on class).
- Each group uses the **Mindmap sheet** provided as additional learning material **to brainstorm strategies for helping the EU achieve its carbon neutrality goals**. It could be using LED lighting, biking to school instead of taking the car or bus, eating locally farmed food, and so on.
- Following that, **each group shares their ideas to the others**.
